

YMCC CLUB RULES

ONLINE 'BOOKING IN'

- 🏠 'Booking in' prior to meetings via the forum should be done by members that wish to race.
- 🏠 'Booking in' is not mandatory BUT ensures that numbers are adequate for racing – you can also order food this way...
- 🏠 Once booked in, if you cannot race on the day please contact us via the details on the website/forum
- 🏠 To run a class we need at least four of the same car otherwise it's not feasible.

RACE FEES

- 🏠 Competitors must pay on the day for racing and food/beverages. See the website for prices and special offers.




RACING

- 🏠 Competitors are advised to have their car/s set-up and ready to go prior to arriving at the track.
- 🏠 If a personal transponder (PT) is required it should be collected and installed prior to your race/heat and then promptly returned after each heat/final.
- 🏠 Once you have completed your final lap within the allocated time please drive and wait in the waiting area after the first corner (marked with cones).
- 🏠 The race meeting will be run via a timing system that ensures we finish within time – Be ready on the line for your heat/race as the clock will not wait for you.





MARSHALLING

- 🏠 All racers will marshal for the next race/heat when they finish.
- 🏠 All marshals must wear a high visibility vest
- 🏠 Marshalling should be done safely, make sure you do not run onto the track in front of cars racing, wait till its safe to do so.
- 🏠 When returning someone's car to the track, do not merely dump it on the track, make sure it is facing the right way, and if it has jumped a curb, be sure to return it to the side it came from.
- 🏠 Be especially careful not to place a car back in front of an oncoming car.
- 🏠 At the end of the heat that you are marshalling, do not leave your point until all cars have finished.




TRACKSIDE RULES

-  No food or beverages are allowed into the fenced area .
-  Spectators are not to stand inside the track boundaries, except for special events.
-  All drivers must stand on the floor of the rostrum platform. Sitting on the rails or standing on loose objects is expressly forbidden.




RACING CONDUCT

-  All members and guest must drive with due care and attention at all times.
-  The Race director must be adhered to at all times and has final call on all race incidents.
-  Deliberately caused collisions will not be tolerated nor is voicing your 'personal' opinion to other drivers.
-  If you feel you have been involved in a race incident please consult the referee and race directors who will happily resolve the dispute using our state of the art trackside CCTV

ELECTRONIC ENTRY CARDS

-  The card is for the use of the membership holder only.
-  If the card is lost or stolen it must be reported to one of the committee members within 48hrs of it going missing. Contact details on the website.
-  If a replacement card is required then a fee of £25 must be paid in all cases.

PRACTICE SESSIONS

-  All members and guests visiting the track for a practice session must sign in and out of the school grounds at the Caretakers office
-  Non-members must stay outside the compound of the track area..
-  You can use your electronic entry card to practice at the track during the following times:

Open practice **outside school term:**

Mon-Fri: 9am-8pm

Sat: 9am-5pm

Sun: 9am-5pm (when there is no meeting)

Open practice **within school term:**

Mon-Fri: 4pm-8pm

Sat: 9am-5pm

Sun: 9am-5pm (when there is no meeting)

NOTE: You do not need to do this for our usual Sunday meetings, only when you visit the track for practice sessions during the designated times below.
